- You must have an active financial interview on file
- You must have a balance of \$50 or more and pay in full

What To Bring To Apply for Medicaid or Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP)

Please bring the following documents that apply to you and your family to your enrollment appointment.

Valid Picture ID (Driver's license, State ID card, Passport, or Permanent Resident Card)

Birth Certificate for each member of your family that is applying for Medicaid

Social Security Card for each member of your family that is applying for Medicaid (even if you have a social security card for work purposes only)

Proof of Pregnancy (if you are pregnant)

Proof of Immigration Status (if not a US Citizen and if able to be provided)

- Permanent resident card
- Certification of Naturalization
- Passport / Visa
- Documentation from the Bureau for Citizenship and Immigration Services

Proof of address (no handwritten addresses)

- A piece of mail with your name and current mailing address that you have received in the past 30 days
- Copy of lease, if renting
- Mortgage statement, if you own a home
- Utility statement

Proof of household income for the last 90 days (please bring all that apply)

- 3 months of current pay stubs, **or** a letter from your employer on company letterhead that includes your start date, number of hours worked weekly, and hourly rate of pay
- Weekly benefit amount of unemployment
- If self-employed, most current income taxes and records of monthly income
- Pension statements
- School grants information
- Social Security Benefits award letter (SSI or SSDI)
- Child support income

Proof of no income for household members

- If you have not had an income for more than 30 days, please provide a letter stating that. You may also provide a letter from whomever is currently providing you with financial support.
- If you have had an income in the past 30 days, please provide your last pay stub and a signed letter from your previous employer with the last date of employment, amount you were paid on your final pay check, and how long you were employed.
